

# Bwoga Elementary Library (BEL) Initiative Q1 REPORT

## **Executive Summary**

The BEL Initiative continues to grow, creating opportunities for the Bwoga community. Thank you so much for your support. Indeed, through your generosity, many Bwoga kids will continue to have access to books and other educational resources.

**Library Operations:** The library was officially opened in December 2023. [If you missed the news article about the library opening, I have attached a copy to this report]. Currently, we are working on stocking the library with books, furniture and computers. The library continues to host the BEL Holiday Reading Program for primary (elementary & middle) school kids. In addition to the reading program, the library is running a basic computer training program for high school students, and a weaving-skills training for a group of Bwoga women.

# **BEL Scholarship program**

The number of beneficiaries of the BEL scholarship program increased from 15 in 2023 to 21 in 2024. BEL greatly appreciates the new sponsors who have joined the cause to support these children..

The benefit of having a sponsor for a student is profound. Sponsors not only provide financial support but also develop meaningful relationships with the students. They may serve as mentors, and occasionally check with the students to track their progress.

Our goal is to increase the number of BEL scholarship beneficiaries to 25 by the end of this year. On average, sponsoring a child costs about \$450 per year. This scholarship covers the main aspects of the student's education, including tuition, fees, room & board, and school supplies.

## **Holiday Reading Program**

Our 2024 Holiday Reading program commenced on May 6th. The reading program's theme is "Leadership and Responsibility." The reason for highlighting this theme is especially to remind the kids of a key goal of the library (transforming their community through leadership), and their role in taking great care of this wonderful resource. We hope that this reading program (and others to come) will continue to empower our Bwoga kids to take ownership of the library as their own and recognize the lasting impact it will have on future generations.

To make the theme relevant, students will participate in a variety of activities, including making crafts and offering community service (e.g. cleaning around the library and the Bwoga community health center). Additionally, as part of the Holiday Reading program, BEL aims to help Bwoga kids close academic gaps in English (reading, writing, and grammar) and in mathematics (essential math sense).
